1. Introduction

1. Rajasthan state NEET PG (MDS) counselling is done for admission to all RUHS CDS and all Private Dental Colleges of Rajasthan.
2. 50% seats of RUHS CDS of the State will be filled from All India Quota for which Counselling is done by Medical Counselling Committee and remaining 50% State quota seats of RUHS CDS along with all seats of Private Dental colleges of Rajasthan will be allotted through Rajasthan state NEET PG (MDS) Counselling 2026.
3. Rajasthan State NEET PG (MDS) Counselling 2026 shall be done by NEET PG (MDS) Admission/Counselling Board 2026 constituted by the State Government. All the allotments will be done by the above Admission/ Counselling Board comprising of all Principals/Representatives of Principals of Dental Colleges of the State of Rajasthan.
4. The Rajasthan NEET PG (MDS) Counselling will be conducted as per the rules and regulations given by National Dental Commission (NDC) and directions from the Central Govt., State Govt. and in compliance to latest orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court and Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court.
5. The role of State NEET PG (MDS) Admission/Counselling Board is limited to allotment of seats to the participating candidates, as per their merit, choice and roster as per applicable reservation policy of state government, which starts only after receiving the list/data/Information of successful/qualified candidates from NEET PG (MDS) examination conducting body, received by above Admission/Counselling Board through the State Government/ Directorate of Medical Education (DME).
6. Allotment of Course and College to the candidate shall be strictly made according to the merit, the choice(s) filled by the candidate and availability of the seats as per the reservation policy of the state and in accordance with the rules and the directions laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/ Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court/NDC/NMC/Government of Rajasthan, **but the admission will be subject to verification of his/her documents/credentials for which the decision of the Principal of the concerned allotted college or the State NEET PG (MDS) Admission/Counselling Board shall be final.**
7. The allotment of seat to the candidates is made based on the NEET-MDS Examination. **Only NEET MDS 2026 qualified and candidates registered with Rajasthan State NEET PG (MDS) Admission/Counselling Board 2026 shall be eligible for admission in state quota counselling.**

2. Instructions for Candidates

NOTE: Qualified and eligible candidates are required to register on the Rajasthan State Counselling website i.e. <https://mds.neetrajasthan.com> in order to participate in the state counselling process for allotment of seat. State NEET PG (MDS) Admission/ Counselling Board 2026 does not allot any seat either on nomination basis or manually.

Candidates are advised to refer the website regularly for updated and relevant information.

Candidates are further advised to fill the application form on their own and not through any agent or third party

1. Candidates must go through the Information bulletin, instructions for filling online application form, seat matrix, all notification(s) and College Information sheets, Fee information sheets, bond conditions, etc., available at the website, before proceeding for the Counselling process.
2. Candidates must have read agreed and accepted the Counselling scheme and the terms and conditions of the Counselling scheme for Rajasthan State NEET PG (MDS) counselling on completing the online application/registration form.
3. Application/Registration for Rajasthan State NEET PG (MDS) Counselling can only be submitted online through above mentioned website and only once by a candidate. Application/Registration submitted through any other mode shall not be considered. Any Candidate submitting more than one application/registration in same round will be debarred from the Counselling process.
4. The candidates will be required to deposit security amount for participation in Counselling through choice filling process and such **security deposit will be forfeited if a candidate who has been allotted a seat in the second and subsequent rounds does not join the respective institution. Security deposit will also be forfeited if the admission gets cancelled due to any reason for eg:- if the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or the candidate fails to produce the required documents at the time of admission within the stipulated time period.**
5. Candidates must be aware that registering for State NEET PG (MDS) counselling does not provide any rights to secure a seat. The admission shall be subject to state merit, admission criteria and eligibility as per NDC/MCC norms.
6. Candidate must ensure that all information submitted through the online Counselling registration and application/registration process is accurate, complete and factual. The information provided by the candidate shall be treated as final and self-certified. Therefore, candidates are advised to verify all details carefully before final submission. No request for correction, modification, or change in the information submitted during the Counselling

process will be entertained under any circumstances except if notified. The data entered by the candidate at the time of registration will be used for counselling purposes including name, DOB, Category etc., **Information submitted in PART I of application form will not be edited in any circumstances.**

7. Counselling board does not alter any information entered by the candidate at the time of online submission of application/registration forms for Counselling under any circumstances
8. The information regarding Stipend /fee structure/ course duration / bond amount / rendering of service must be checked by candidates prior to participation in Counselling process. Candidates are advised to check the counselling website and also visit the college website for any query regarding information related to fee details/hostel accommodation/bond amount/stipend/surety bonds/service bonds prior to filling choices.
9. After choices get locked, they cannot be modified and any request regarding the editing/modifications of choices will not be entertained.
10. The Admission/Counselling authority reserves the absolute and unfettered right, at its sole discretion to alter, amend, modify, supplement, withdraw or implement any or of the provision, instruction, guidelines or procedures contained in this information bulletin as deemed necessary from time to time. In the event of any ambiguity, inconsistency, dispute or question arising with respect to the interpretation or application of any provision/instructions/terms/rules/eligibility criteria/counselling procedure/candidate registration process or any other matter contained herein, the interpretation, clarification and decision of the NEET PG(MDS) Admission/Counselling Board shall be final, conclusive and binding upon all candidates and other stakeholders and shall not be opened to challenge except and may be provided under the applicable laws.
11. Candidates are requested to use their own Mobile Number and Email ID (personal) during the Counselling registration process since the OTPs will be sent to the Email ID for verification.
12. This is to inform the candidates that all Admissions and Resignation (if allowed) will be made by the respective institution through online mode only. Candidate must obtain the resignation letter generated from the Counselling website from the College authorities after updation of resignation from the allotted seat at the respective college as no offline resignation of seat is permitted in this Counselling Process.
13. Candidates must download the allotment letter from the Counselling website and must preserve a copy of same with them for further needful.
14. All Candidates must furnish the primary and alternative bank account numbers (preferably of self/parent) with all required bank account and account holder details at the time of registration as the security amount will be refunded to the primary account with or to the alternate account (only in case of rejection of refund amount/transferred to primary account).
15. All refunds shall be processed after the completion of Counselling process. **No request for refund of security amount during the Counselling process shall be entertained.**

16. Candidates must note that the application/registration fee is non-refundable in all circumstances and no request for the refund of application/registration fees is considerable.
17. Candidates must check the reservation policy of the state prior to participation in Counselling process.
18. Allotment of seat to reserved category candidates shall be subject to production of valid requisite certificate.
19. OBC – NCL, MBC – NCL and EWS candidate(s) must upload the valid certificate issued by the competent authority of the state of Rajasthan of their category applicable for the current academic session that is valid for the admission year 2026 while doing registration and also produce the same at the time of reporting for their reservation eligibility. **EWS certificate should be valid and issued for the year 2026-27.**
20. PwBD/PwD Eligibility certificates issued from any one of the 66 MCC authorized Medical Assessment Boards (Annexure – 1 A) shall be considered for their reservation eligibility. The Candidates must upload this certificate along with their permanent UDID card(s) (issued by the department of empowerment of Persons with Disabilities of the State) on the Counselling website at the time of registration which will be downloaded and verified by the Counselling authorities. No PwBD/PwD candidate will be required to come in person for verification of PwBD/PwD Status. The eligibility certificate issued as per NMC/MCC notification for the academic session 2026-27 shall only be considered valid.
21. In case the eligibility certificate/UDID card uploaded/submitted by the candidate is found to be **FAKE**, the seat of the candidate will be cancelled along with forfeiture of the security deposit and legal action will be taken against such candidate(s).
22. Any grievance related to the Counselling process shall be sent to the provided Email Id available on the Counselling website and redressal of the grievance shall be done at the earliest possible depending on the issue raised in the grievance.
23. Candidates are advised to contact on the provided contact numbers available on website in case of technical issues and the team involved in Counselling process shall be ready to help at the earliest.
24. Candidates are advised to check all information/Updates on the Counselling website only. They are requested not to believe on fake/ Malicious websites and fraudulent/Spam messages.
25. Candidates must ensure to preserve their credentials, login Ids and passwords/OTPs if any during participation in Counselling process. Admission/Counselling authorities should not be made responsible for revelation of passwords/information/OTPs to unauthorized persons.

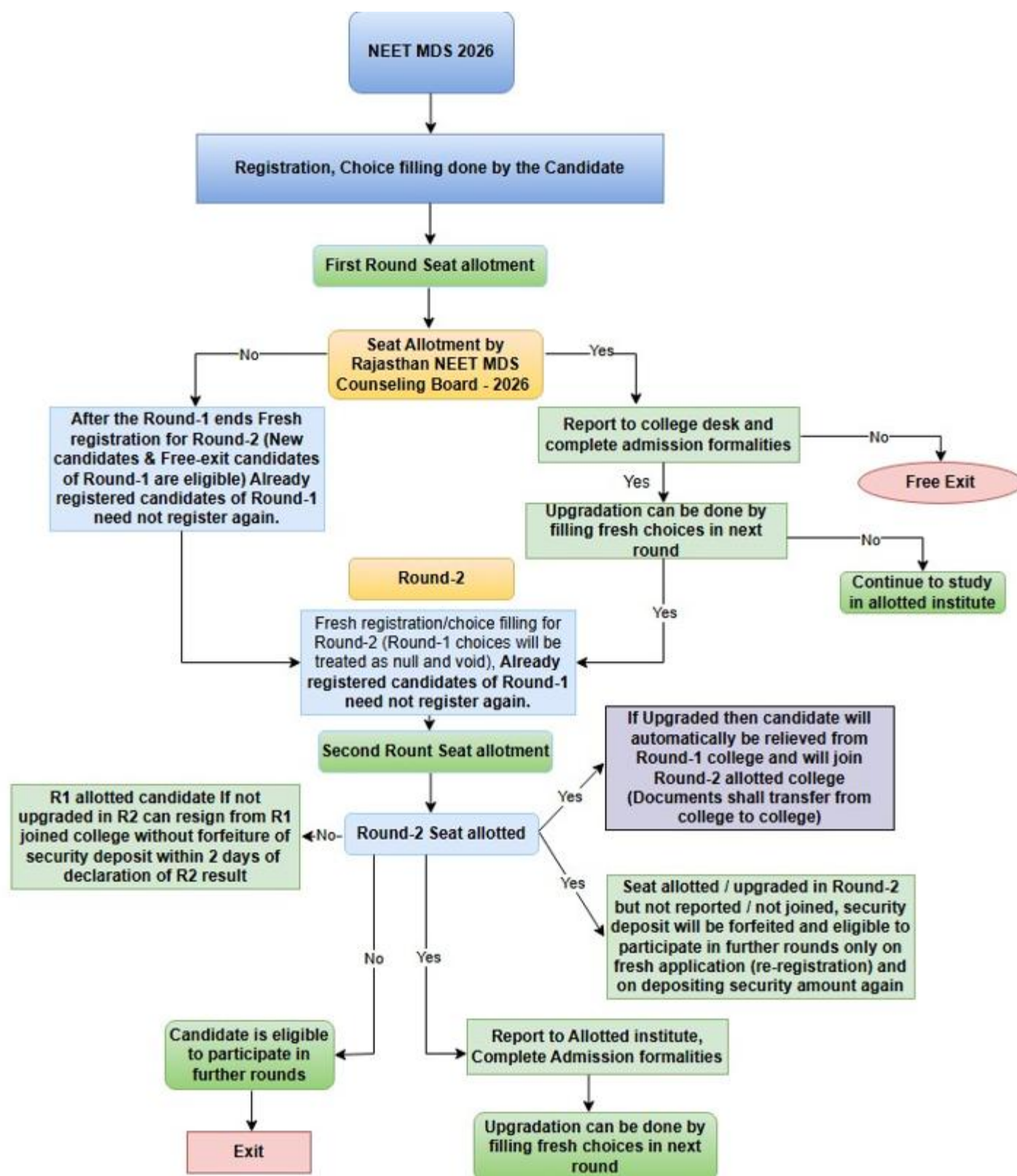
4. Counselling Scheme

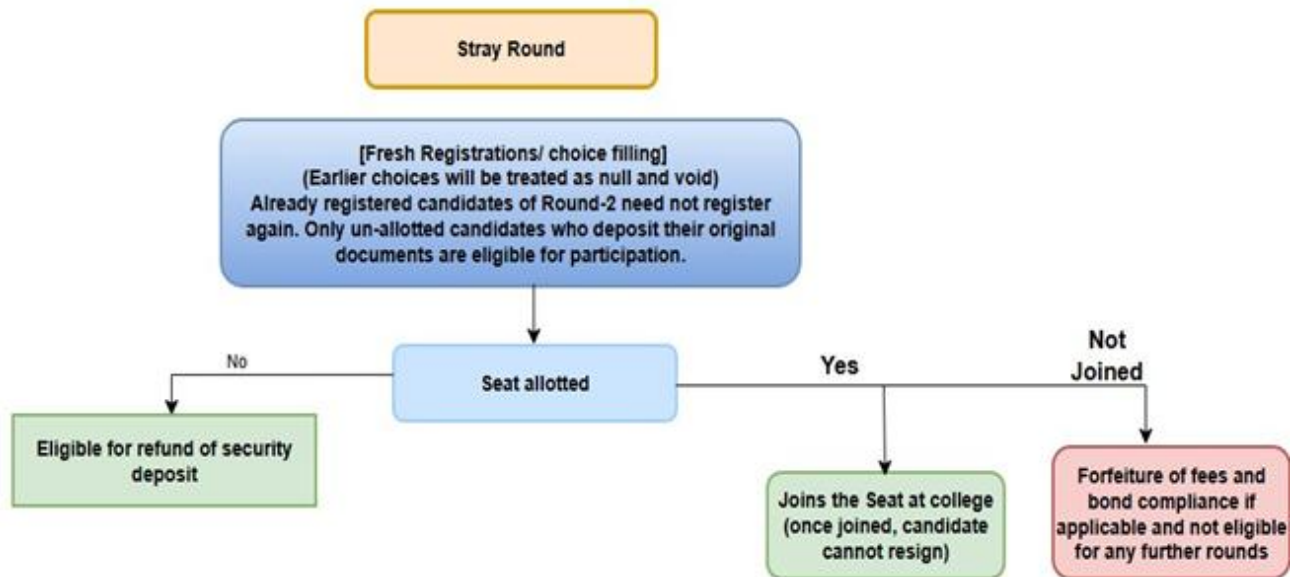
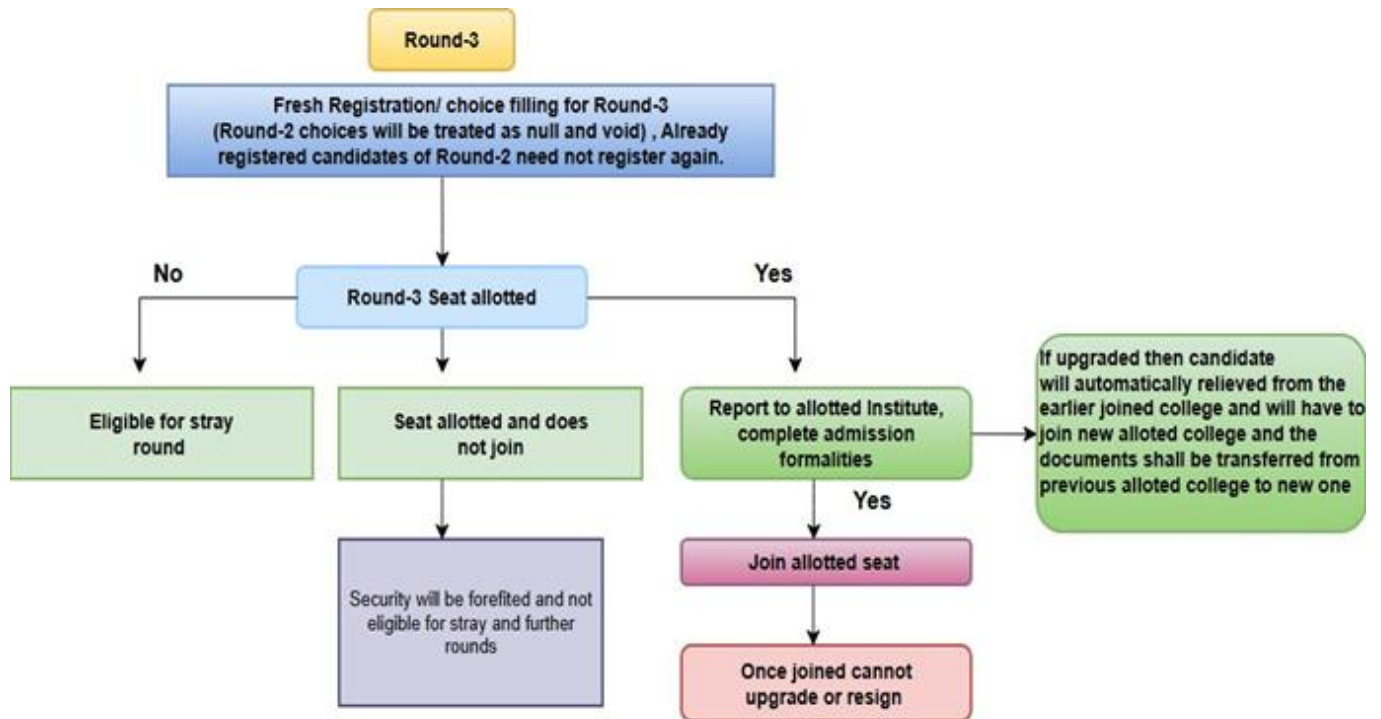
1. **Four online rounds of Counselling** will be conducted i.e. **Round 1, Round 2, Round 3, and, Stray Vacancy Round**. **All four rounds of allotments including stray vacancy round shall be conducted On-Line. No Round shall be conducted off-line. No admission shall be made at College level.**
2. The Counselling process shall be conducted in four rounds. The facility for upgradation will be available up to Round 3.
3. **Note*:-** Candidates are advised to take an informed decision of continuing in Third round of AIQ or other states as they would not be permitted to resign from 3rd round of AIQ or other states and they will also not be allowed to participate in State Counselling after **joining** in Third Round of AIQ. There will be Data sharing between Centre and the States and if any candidate has his/her name in the list of joined candidates in either of the lists, then name of such candidate shall be eliminated from the Stray Vacancy Round.
4. **Round 1 is free exit round** and if the candidate is not satisfied with the allotted seat, he/she may not join the seat and such non-joining of the candidate to the allotted seat will not result in forfeiture of the deposited security amount. The candidate(s) will be eligible for participation in the further rounds.
5. Upgradation shall be permitted in Round 2 and Round 3 by filling fresh choices again. Fresh registrations will be done in Round 2 and Round 3. Already registered candidates need not register again, until his/her security deposit is forfeited in previous round and as per rules.
6. A Candidate, **if not upgraded in Round 2 can resign, within 2 days of declaration of Round 2 result without forfeiture of Security deposit.** There will be forfeiture of security deposit in case of Non-joining after Round 2 allotments for candidates who are upgraded and newly allotted in Round 2. Such Candidates can only participate in further round after registering again (re-registration) and depositing the security amount again.
7. AIQ allotted candidates can resign (only in Round1 or 2) after joining in state with forfeiture of security deposit as per notification, if made available by MCC on their website in due course of time.
8. Non-joining to Round 3 allotted/upgraded seats will result in forfeiture of security deposit. Such candidate shall not be eligible for participation in the Stray Vacancy Round.
9. Only the candidates who have not been allotted any seat till Round 3 in state and MCC Counselling and the free exit candidates of Round 1, if not allotted any seat in further Rounds are eligible for participation in the Stray Vacancy Round subject to deposition of all

original documents along with requisite bond/s as consent towards participation and Joining of allotted seat in the Stray Vacancy Round. Bond compliance should be done in case of Non- joining on allotted seat in the stray vacancy round. Fresh registrations will also be done in Stray Vacancy Round.

10. Once Joined in Round 3, candidates can't upgrade and will not be allowed to resign.
11. No resignations are permitted after joining of Round 2 seat. Resignations shall only be allowed as per notifications for AIQ Round 2 and Round 3 allotted candidates, as per notification.
12. Conversion of seats will be done during and after Round 3 allotments after exhaustion of reserved category lists by following the conversion algorithm as per reservation policy of State of Rajasthan. All category PwBD/PwD seats shall be converted to respective category seats and STA to ST and other reserved category seats viz. ST, SC, OBC-NCL, MBC-NCL & EWS will be converted to UR (un-reserved) seats.
13. State Eligibility criteria shall be strictly applicable till round 3. In stray vacancy Round allotment first made applying state eligibility criteria, seat remaining thereafter will be allotted on merit basis.
14. The Counselling Scheme is provided below in flow chart for convenience of candidates.

5. Eligibility Criteria

I. State Eligibility

On 50% of the total seats in Government colleges as well as 50% of the total seats in Private Colleges, the NEET qualified candidates who possess the degree of BDS from the colleges situated in the State of Rajasthan and all medical officers (dental) /medical teachers (dental) serving under Government of Rajasthan are eligible to participate, but on 25% seats out of these seats in Govt. colleges, preference shall be given to the candidates who possess the degree of BDS from the University of Rajasthan / Rajasthan University of Health Sciences; and for the remaining 50% of the total seats of Private Colleges, all NEET Qualified candidates who possess the recognized degree of BDS from anywhere are eligible to participate;

Note: State eligibility criteria, as mentioned in clause (i) for state quota seats shall be applicable upto round 3 allotment process. Any seat remaining vacant after round 3 shall be filled in stray vacancy round without applying the state eligibility criteria.

Provisions for Senior Demonstrators: As per Government order dated 31.03.2017 and 05.04.2017, regularly selected Senior Demonstrator working in Non-Clinical & Para Clinical Departments of colleges run by Government, Government Societies and Government Universities will be given priority (in the same department in which they are working) in Non-Clinical & Para-Clinical PG Degree seats allotment. They will be considered only after completing three years of regular service in the same department and qualifying the NEET examination. NOC (specifying service duration also) of the employer will also be necessary.

II. Academic Eligibility

Applicable to all categories

The candidate should have-

- obtained BDS qualification recognized by DCI/ NDC
- Completed satisfactorily one year's compulsory rotatory internship (**as on 31.05.2026**) after passing the final BDS examination. No condonation of compulsory rotatory internship shall be accepted.
- Obtained registration from DCI/NDC Rajasthan or other state Dental Council (provisional or permanent).
- Secured minimum of marks at 50th percentile [40th percentile in case of natural born

SC, ST, OBC, MBC (more backward classes) and 45th percentile in case of locomotor disabled for unreserved/EWS candidates] in the NEET PG (MDS) 2026.

In-service category

- Weightage of Bonus Marks in the obtained NEET PG (MDS) 2026 score shall be given to all eligible in-service candidates after verification by Directorate of Medical and Health Department, Rajasthan.
- Other criteria / conditions shall be as per the Government of Rajasthan norms i.e. service conditions, age etc.

Note: Candidates must ensure that they have scored minimum qualifying percentile in NEET MDS 2026 before addition of bonus marks to be eligible for application form filling and registration for State Counselling.

III. Reservation Eligibility

All admissions to MDS courses shall be given as per reservation roster. Whatever the seats in whichever Dental colleges are available as per merit will be allotted to the candidates as per Reservation Roster of state of Rajasthan and as per their choice. At roster point of UR, all candidates will be considered as per their merit but at roster point of SC, ST, STA, OBC-NCL, MBC-NCL, EWS, the concerned category candidates will be considered as per their merit.

Treatment to be given to the candidates belonging to the SC/ST/BC who are selected against open category vacancies on the basis of their merit shall be as per circular no. F.7(1)DOP/A-II/99 Dated 26-07-2017 issued by the Department of Personnel, Rajasthan.

Note: As per letter no. F7(111)/DME/PG/2020/Part/1345, dated 17.03.2020 of Directorate of Medical Education and UO Note no. F7(1)/DOP/A-2/19 dated 22.02.2019 of DOP (A-2) Department, the EWS reservation shall be applicable on all educational institutions.

Not less than 25% seats out of each category of SC, ST, STA, OBC-NCL, MBC-NCL, EWS and open category shall be filled from female candidates.

The norms of reservation of the State Government of Rajasthan will be applicable only for bonafide candidates of the State of Rajasthan. SC / ST / OBC NCL / MBC NCL/EWS candidates of states other than Rajasthan state shall be considered as

open category candidates. All candidates of reserved category shall submit valid caste / EWS certificate as per State Government rules.

Note:

OBC NCL / MBC NCL candidate must submit valid OBC NCL / MBC NCL Certificate (clearly indicating 'Non Creamy Layer') for Rajasthan State by competent authority of Rajasthan. Refer the direction letter no. 54159, dated 09.09.2015 issued by Social Justice and Empowerment Department, Govt. of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

EWS candidate must submit EWS Certificate (Valid for Financial year 2026-27) for Rajasthan State issued by competent authority of Rajasthan

PwBD/PwD reservation

5% seats shall be reserved horizontally for candidates with specified disabilities (PwBD/PwD) under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and in accordance with the provisions of the "Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2024". It is clarified that PwBD/PwD candidates shall be considered on the roster point reserved for PwBD/PwD as per his/her PwBD/PwD merit.

"Eligibility Certificate" issued from a designated Primary Medical Assessment Board of MCC for 21 Benchmark Disabilities as per the Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016 and NMC Norms, issued by 65 centers approved by MCC shall only be considered. Latest guidelines are attached as Annexure-1.

List of approved centers is attached as Annexure – 1A.

The candidate must bring the certificate issued to them, at the time of joining.

No other certificate, issued by any other Authorities/ Hospital will be entertained.

Unfilled reserved seat(s)

During / after the round 3 of counselling and on exhaustion of the list of reserved category candidates the roster point earmarked for that category shall be treated un-reserved and shall be filled accordingly.

6. Seat matrix

The seat matrix will be published in due course at the website (<https://mds.neetrajasthan.com>). Responsibility of type of seats in the seat matrix shall lie with the concerned institution and not with the Counselling Board. Updated Vacant seat matrix will also be made available on counselling website before the start of each round of counselling.

7. Fee Details

Fee details as provided by the concerned institute will be published in due course. Responsibility of type of seats and Fee levied on such seats shall lie with the concerned institution and not with the State Counselling Board.

Refer order dated 19.05.2022 of Hon'ble Supreme Court in civil appeal no. 3978-3995/2017.

8. Application/Registration fee

All candidates are required to deposit non-refundable application fee of Rs. 4000/- (Rs. 3000/- for SC, ST/STA category candidate of Rajasthan state domicile) + applicable transaction charges.

The application/registration fee is neither refundable, nor transferable and nor adjustable for any future State MDS admissions.

Any plea in this matter shall not be entertained.

9. Application / Registration procedure

Before proceeding, candidates are advised to read thoroughly the information bulletin, notification and other information etc. very carefully.

You should be very careful in filling-up the on-line application form. If any lapse is detected during the scrutiny, your candidature may be rejected even if you come through the final stage of admission process or even at a later stage.

IMPORTANT: HANDWRITTEN / TYPED / PHOTOSTAT COPIES / PRINTED APPLICATION FORM/ SCREEN PRINTOUT WILL NOT BE ENTERTAINED.

Make sure of your eligibility etc. and that the declaration made by you regarding your eligibility is correct in all respects. You will be liable to legal action and / or punishment as may be deemed fit by the Admission Board in case it is found that you have furnished in-correct information or made false declaration or suppressed any information regarding your eligibility at any stage.

The jurisdiction for legal cases arising out of PG (MDS) Admissions/Allotments 2026 shall be limited to the Rajasthan High Court only.

The decision of the Admission Board in all aspects pertaining to the application and its acceptance or rejection as the case may be, conduct of Counselling and at all consequent stages culminating in the admission or otherwise of any candidate shall be final and binding on all concerned.

The admission board reserves its right to alter and modify time schedule and conditions laid down in the notification, instruction booklet for conducting the various stages up to the admission, duly intimating details thereof on the website, as warranted by any unforeseen circumstances arising during the course of this process, or as deemed necessary by the admission board at any stage.

The NEET PG (MDS) Counselling Board 2026 will not be responsible for any consequences arising out of forgotten password / misuse of your password. It is your responsibility to maintain confidentiality of your password. Sharing of your password can result in its misuse by somebody else, leading to even exclusion of a genuine candidate from the on-line allotment process.

Please keep the information submitted in application form confidential and do not share with anybody. If you have filled application form but have not filled your choices during the notified period, you will not be considered for allotment but will be considered subsequently subject to fulfilling the applicable conditions.

No request for enabling choice filling shall be entertained after the stipulated time period.

Candidates are advised to keep checking the schedule for each round and be well in time to ensure smooth participation in counselling process by avoiding last minute hassles and technical issues.

All eligible candidates who wish to participate in the Counselling process must register themselves through the above mentioned website by completing Part 1 as well as Part 2 of application form.

A candidate, who fails to register by completing both Part 1 as well as Part 2 of application form, shall not be eligible to participate in the further process of Counselling.

Only NEET MDS 2026 qualified and registered with Rajasthan State PG Counselling Board 2026 candidates shall be eligible for admission.

Keep visiting the website regularly for notifications and updates regarding same.

Follow the steps as given in “Application Guidelines” available at the website.

Note the Login credentials i.e., Username and password received on the registered Email ID for further steps and candidates must keep it safe and confidential. Please note the username and preserve it safe. In case of missing/forgetting of login credentials, the candidates can access their login password through “FORGOT YOUR PASSWORD” application.

The counselling authorities shall not be held responsible for loss of login credentials and consequences of giving the login credentials and password to any unauthorized person.

10. Security amount

Before choice filling stage, candidates participating will have to pay refundable / adjustable security amount as under:

Rs. 25,000/- for all candidates opting for MDS course in RUHS College of Dental Sciences and Private Dental colleges

The Security Deposit will be forfeited if a candidate who has been allotted a seat in the round 2 or subsequent rounds and does not join the respective institution.

Also, the Security Deposit will be forfeited if the admission gets cancelled due to any reason e.g in case the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration (application form filling) on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Board or fails to produce the required essential documents at the time of joining (within stipulated time).

If a candidate joins his allotted seat in any round of counselling, his/her security amount will be adjusted in the tuition fee to be deposited for the allotted college.

The security amount if not forfeited or adjusted in fee, will be refunded after completion of Counselling process, to the concerned bank account from as per the details furnished by the candidates.

A candidate allotted a seat in round 1 and does not join the allotted college will be eligible for subsequent round without forfeiture of security amount.

Round 1 joined candidate who has not been up-graded during round 2 Counselling or has not participated in round 2 may resign without forfeiture of security amount within two days of declaration of round 2 result, failing which he will be considered as joined candidate for round 2 and rules will apply accordingly

11.Choice filling

The guidelines and requirements for choice filling will be available with publication of seat matrix. Candidates must fill their choices, very carefully, based on the seat matrix and corresponding fee structure.

Any candidate opting seats permitted by the DCI/NDC will not be allowed to claim for any change on this ground, except during subsequent allotment depending upon his/her merit and as per preference only.

If a candidate does not submit his/her choice till the specified date and time, he/she will lose chance of participation in the on-line allotment process. The choices are required to be filled **very carefully** as the choices filled shall be final for on-line allotments for that round only.

It is mandatory to fill fresh choices in each and every round irrespective of whether the candidate was allotted/joined a seat in previous round or not (subject to the candidate is eligible to participate and willing to participate/upgrade in subsequent round). The choices filled by a candidate in previous round shall be scraped off and will not be considered for further rounds.

Note: If a candidate does not fill fresh choices for a round then he/she will not be considered for allotment / upgradation in that round.

Candidates participating in round 2 or round 3 of the counselling may fill the choices also for the virtual vacancies that may arise due to upgradation by a joined candidate of earlier round.

Candidate participating in the counselling process shall be considered on the vacancies available at his/her merit cum roster point. Any virtual vacancy that may arise after passing over of the merit cum roster point of a candidate shall not be available to that candidate.

It is clarified that any virtual vacancy that may arise due to upgradation by a joined candidate shall be available only to the candidates on next roster point.

If a round 1 allotted and joined candidate does not fill choices for round 2, then he/she will not be considered for upgradation in round 2 (as per his/her merit) and the seat allotted to him/her in round 1 will be considered retained as such.

If a round 1 / round 2 allotted and joined candidate does not fill choices for round 3 (as per the applicable procedure), then he/she will not be considered for upgradation in round 3 (as per his/her merit) and the seat allotted to him/her in round 1 / round 2 will be considered retained as such.

Allotments

The allotment of the subject and college / institute shall be made strictly on the basis of merit cum preference as per the reservation roster and in accordance with the rules laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court/DCI/NMC/NBE/ Government of Rajasthan.

Inter-se merit

Merit list shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in NEET MDS 2026 after adding bonus marks if any as notified by the State Government according to the rules and regulations of the concerned Regulating Authority. The inter-se merit of the candidates securing equal marks will be in the following order:

- One who has higher rank in NEET MDS 2026
- The candidate of higher age (older candidate).
- One who has passed final BDS in lesser number of attempts.
- One who has secured more percentage (aggregate) in BDS.

A candidate allotted a seat (fresh / upgraded) in round 2 of Counselling and does not join the allotted seat, his/her security amount will be forfeited. Such candidate shall not be eligible to participate in further rounds of counselling.

Any candidate who retains his round 1 allotted seat (after two days of declaration of result of 2nd round of counselling) and candidates who join their round 2 allotted seat will not be allowed to resign (including returning of original documents) on or before the last date of admissions as scheduled by MCC/DCI/NDC.

A candidate having joined status on completion of round 2 and willing to participate for upgradation in round 3 will be eligible only on fresh application and on depositing security amount again. His/her earlier deposited security amount will be forfeited.

A candidate allotted a seat (fresh / upgraded) in round 3 of Counselling and does not join the allotted seat, his/her security amount will be forfeited. Such candidate shall not be eligible to participate in stray vacancy round.

A candidate allotted a seat in stray vacancy round does not join the allotted seat **shall be debarred from participating in the State Counselling process for next one year**, along with forfeiture of security amount.

Candidates having joined status after round 3 will not be allowed to participate in Stray vacancy round.

Candidate who joins the course on allotment of round-3 counselling or retains his or her seat (allotted in earlier round) in round-3 or a candidate who joins the course on allotment in stray vacancy round, shall not be allowed to resign the course (including returning of original documents) on or before the last date of admissions as scheduled by MCC/DCI.

Note:

No candidate can join two colleges/institutes at the same time. At the time of round 3 of the allotment process, such candidates who have registered for the state Counselling and who have joined other college/institute (as on a specified date) through round 3 All India Counselling or any other Counselling and hence as per the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court shall be in-eligible for allotment in State round 3 and stray vacancy round.

Stray Vacancy Round: For participation in stray vacancy round, it is mandatory for eligible candidates to get their documents verified and submit all relevant original documents along with a Bond in prescribed format, with the Board. Candidate whose documents are not verified or who does not submit his /her original documents along with bond, will not be allowed to participate in stray vacancy round. Documents of such candidates will be kept by the counselling board after verification. Documents of candidates who do not get any allotment will be returned by the dates notified.

After exhaustion of Candidates having State Eligibility, the State Quota Seats remaining vacant are also available to All India Candidates. Hence candidates eligible to participate In Stray Vacancy Round are required to fill all types of seats in his/her choices.

12. Joining at the allotted college

All candidates allotted a seat through State NEET PG Counselling for MDS Course will have to report in-person at Academic Block, SMS Medical College, Jaipur (at the desk of the allotted college) by the notified date and time.

Round 1

The candidates who get allotment will have to deposit one year tuition fees with the Chairman of NEET PG Counselling/admission Board only through electronic (on-line) mode. Candidate will then have to deposit the proof of on-line deposition of fee along with all original documents and requisite bond to the representative of allotted college (please refer to respective college website). The bank account details of counselling board for online fee deposition will be made available on the website.

Round 2

The candidates who get allotment will have to deposit one year tuition fees with the chairman of NEET PG Counselling/admission Board only through electronic (on-line) mode. Candidate will then have to deposit the proof of on-line deposition of fee along with all original documents and requisite bond to the representative of allotted college (please refer to respective college website). The bank account details of counselling board for online fee deposition will be made available on the website.

Round 1 allotted and joined candidates will be considered for upgradation in round 2. For this upgradation, a round 1 allotted and joined candidate is mandatorily required to fill choices for round 2. In case he/she is allotted a different seat in round 2, his/her seat allotted (and joined) in the round 1 will automatically be vacated (and will be available for allotment to other candidates) and such a candidate will be required to join at the seat allotted during round 2).

Note: Original documents of the upgraded candidates shall be transferred directly to the upgraded college and will not be handed over to the candidate.

Round 3

The candidates who get allotment will have to deposit one year tuition fees with the chairman of NEET PG Counselling/admission Board only through electronic (on-line) mode. Candidate

will then have to deposit the proof of on-line deposition of fee along with all original documents and requisite bond to the representative of allotted college (please refer to respective college website). The bank account details of counselling board for online fee deposition will be made available on the website.

The candidates who retain round 1 / round 2 allotted seat in round 3 of Counselling and candidates who join in round 3 will have to submit other fees/ charges and complete other formalities as per guidelines given in the respective college website by the last date of joining of round 3 Counselling.

Round 2 allotted and joined candidates will be considered for upgradation in round 3 on fresh application and on depositing security amount again. His earlier deposited security amount will be forfeited. For this upgradation, a round 2 allotted and joined candidate is mandatorily required to fill choices for round 3. In case he/she is allotted a different seat in round 3, his/her seat allotted (and joined) in the round 2 will automatically be vacated (and will be available for allotment to other candidates) and such a candidate will be required to join at the seat allotted during round 3).

Stray Vacancy Round

The candidates who get allotment will have to deposit one year tuition fees with the chairman of NEET PG Counselling/admission Board only through electronic (on-line) mode. Candidate will then have to deposit the proof of on-line deposition of fee along with all original documents and requisite bond to the representative of allotted college (please refer to respective college website). The bank account details of counselling board for online fee deposition will be made available on the website.

The candidates will also have to submit other fees / charges and complete other formalities as per guidelines given in the respective college website at the allotted college, by the date and time notified.

Important (for all rounds)

Each candidate shall join the allotted college and course within the time as mentioned in the allotment letter issued on-line. There is no provision of extension for joining date. The allotment made will be firm and final. Change of college/course from one place to another is not permitted. Therefore, request for the same would not be entertained by the Admission Board after the allotment.

The selected candidates should bring all the requisite documents in original and also submit an undertaking in **Proforma-1** that the submitted documents are in original along with one set of self-attested copies of documents, at the time of joining at the allotted college, failing which their admission shall stand cancelled. These original documents may be kept with the institution till completion of the course.

The academic session will commence from 17.09.2026

The selection for this admission shall be cancelled if the selected candidates do not join at the allotted college and deposit fees upto the stipulated date or whose particulars are found to be incorrect.

The candidates must present the accepted resignation/relieving letter from the institution he/she is pursuing studies at present, at the time of joining. Failure to do so will result in disqualification for admission.

The selected candidates must also carry all requisite certificates and documents in original and also submit an undertaking that the submitted documents are in original along with self-attested copies of the same, at the time of joining and shall deposit the applicable fees as per the notified procedure and complete other formalities within stipulated date and time, failing which their admission shall stand cancelled. These original documents may be kept with the institution till completion of the course.

A candidate without original certificates / documents shall not be allowed to take admission at the allotted college under any circumstances. A candidate who has already been admitted in PG course and has deposited his / her certificates in any dental college/institute / university and participate for Counselling (allotment process) with a certificate stating that "his/her original certificates are deposited with the dental college/ institute / university" (except the college allotted through NEET-MDS Counselling 2026 of Rajasthan state process), will NOT be allowed to take admission at the allotted college.

The colleges shall be provided the list of candidates allotted. The colleges shall verify the credentials of reporting candidates as per this list and check the documents and other required certificates with originals.

The admissions shall be treated as provisional subject to the final decision of any pending case(s) in any court of law, if applicable to these admissions. Further, the provisional status of admission shall stand cleared only after enrolment by the concerned University.

The non-viewing of the websites about allotment information by the candidate shall not be accepted as a ground for non-joining by the scheduled time and date. The candidate's allotment will stand automatically cancelled if he/she does not join IN PERSON at the allotted college as per the notified schedule.

The candidate shall also submit an undertaking (on non-judicial stamp of Rs. 50/ duly notarized) that (a) all documents produced by him/her are in original or (b) in case original documents are lost, stolen or destroyed, the duplicate copy of the documents so submitted are duly issued by the competent authority and (c) if any facts are found false he/she shall be liable for cancellation of his/her admission as well as legal action as may be deemed proper by the State Admission Board / State Government (**Proforma 1**, available in the instruction booklet).

Conditions relating to bond etc. (applicable for RUHS College of Dental Sciences)

Surety Bond

At the time of allotment, the selected candidates (both All India and State quota) will have to submit a surety bond of Rs. 10.00 lacs (Rupees ten lacs) toward 'not to leave the course in between' (proforma available at the website).

At the time of final joining, a separate Bank Guarantee for Rs. 1.5 lacs and Bond for Rs. 8.5 lacs is to be submitted (surety bond of Rs. 10 lacs submitted earlier will be returned).

At the time of joining, all the original certificates of the candidate shall be deposited in the concerned allotted college towards execution of the bonds. The concerned allotted college shall have the right to retain all the original certificates of the students till compliance of the bond conditions.

Conditions relating to bond/bank guarantee* and other formalities (applicable for private colleges)
At the time of joining (on completion of round 3), all the joined candidates of round 1, round 2 as well as round 3 will have to submit a bond / bank guarantee* (if applicable). For details, refer website of respective private colleges / contact college office.

Important: Documents checking and verification

The PG Admission/Counselling Board processes the allotments of college and course to the candidates based on the information filled/provided by the candidates in the on-line application/registration form.

Candidate should be very careful in filling-up the on-line application form and must ensure fulfillment of the eligibility criteria etc. If at any stage a candidate is found non-eligible for admission to the allotted course, his/her candidature is subject to rejection even if he/she comes through the final stage of admission process or even at a later stage.

Final checking and verification of the documents (including prescribed eligibility criteria etc.) will be done as per the applicable procedure, at the level of concerned allotted college, at the time of joining.

A candidate will be deemed to have joined an institution once his/her original documents are submitted, reported physically at the allotted institution desk, Academic Block, SMS Medical College, Jaipur and have deposited the requisite fee.

ELIGIBILITY DECLARATION BY CANDIDATES

Candidate will be liable for any legal action and / or punishment as may be deemed fit by the Admission Board in case it is found that he/she has furnished in-correct information or made false declaration regarding the eligibility at any stage or suppressed any information. The allotted seat shall stand cancelled in case of allotment of seats on basis of any fake or false information provided by the candidate at the time of application/registration and the security amount of such candidates shall stand forfeited.

Important conditions related to security deposits and its forfeiture if applicable-

1. If a candidate joins his allotted seat in any round of counselling, his/her security amount will be adjusted in the tuition fee to be deposited for the allotted college.
2. The security amount, if not forfeited or adjusted in fee, will be refunded after completion of Counselling process, to the bank account submitted at the time of application/registration.

5. A candidate allotted a seat (fresh / upgraded) in round 2 of Counselling and does not join the allotted seat; his/her security amount will be forfeited. Such candidate shall be eligible to participate in further rounds of Counselling ONLY on submission of fresh application/registration (Re-registration) and on depositing the security amount again.
6. Any candidate who retains his round 1 allotted seat (after two days of declaration of result of 2nd round of counselling) and candidates who join their round 2 allotted seat will not be allowed to resign (including returning of original documents) on or before the last date of admissions as scheduled by MCC/NMC/NDC and the conditions of bond (as given in the information bulletin) shall be applicable.
7. A candidate having joined status on completion of round 2 and willing to participate for upgradation in round 3 will be eligible for participation in Round 3 of the counselling.
8. A candidate allotted a seat (fresh / upgraded) in round 3 of Counselling and does not join the allotted seat, his/her security amount will be forfeited. Such candidate shall not be eligible to participate in stray vacancy round.
9. Candidates having joined status after round 3 will not be allowed to participate in Stray vacancy round.
10. A candidate who is allotted a seat in stray vacancy round and does not join the allotted seat **shall be debarred from participating in the State Counselling process in any further rounds, if applicable along with forfeiture of security amount** and bond conditions shall be applicable. Such candidate shall not be eligible for participation if any further round is conducted as per direction of MCC/NMC/NDC/Honorable Courts.
11. Candidate who joins the course on allotment of round-3 counselling or retains his/her seat (allotted in earlier round) in round-3 or a candidate who joins the course on allotment in stray vacancy round, shall not be allowed to resign the course (including

returning of original documents) on or before the last date of admissions as scheduled by MCC/NMC/NDC and conditions of bond (given in information bulletin) shall be applicable.

Note: No candidate can join two colleges/institutes at the same time. At the time of round 2 or 3 of the allotment process, such candidates who have registered for the state Counselling and who have joined other college/institute (as on a specified date) through MDS round 2 or 3 of All India Counselling or any other Counselling and hence as per the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court shall be in-eligible for allotment in State round 2 or 3 and stray vacancy round.

There will be data sharing of joined candidates between center and state and any candidate whose name is any of the lists shall not be eligible for participation in Stray Vacancy Round

Stray Vacancy Round: For participation in stray vacancy round, it is mandatory for eligible candidates to get their documents verified and submit all relevant original documents along with a Bond in prescribed format, with the Board within the stipulated time period for same. Candidate whose documents are not verified or who does not submit his /her original documents along with the requisite bond, will not be allowed to participate in stray vacancy round. Documents of such candidates will be kept by the counselling board after verification and will be handed over to the respective college after joining/reporting of the candidate as per the allotment letter. The original documents of the candidates who do not get any allotment will be returned by the dates notified on personal appearance of candidate him/herself for collecting them.

Standard Operating Procedure for appeal by NEET PwBD Candidates Appearing Before the Appellate Disability Assessment Board

The following process shall be followed for the appraisal and disposal of appeals submitted by NEET PwBD candidates:

Step 1: Submission of Appeal

The candidate declared ineligible by the Primary Disability Assessment Medical Board may submit the appeal on the email IDs given in the portal (disabilityappeal-chair@gov.in and disabilityappeal-convener@gov.in) along with the choice of Appellate Disability Assessment Board, **before the commencement of their respective round of NEET counselling**. The appeal received will be further shared with the chosen Appellate Board for its perusal and further necessary action. Following five are the authorized Appellate Disability Assessment Boards:

- VMMC & Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi
- Grant Government Medical College & Sir JJ Group of Hospitals, Mumbai
- Banaras Hindu University, Banaras
- Madras Medical College, Chennai
- Institute of Post Graduate Medical Education and Research (IPGMER), Kolkata

Step 2: Scheduling of Assessment

Based on the candidate's availability, the date, time, venue and necessary instructions shall be communicated to the candidate by nodal officer of the concerned Appellate Board.

Step 3: Reporting and Verification

On the scheduled date, the candidate shall report to **concerned** appellate board for assessment. All relevant medical and disability-related documents shall be examined by the board during the course of examination.

Step 4: Appellate Disability Assessment

The Appellate Disability Assessment Board shall conduct the disability assessment in accordance with the prevailing **“Guidelines for assessing the extent of specified disabilities” 2024 by DEPwD**. Wherever required, the board may co-opt members for assessment.

Step 5: Final Decision of the Appellate Board

Upon completion of the assessment and review of all relevant records, the Appellate Disability Assessment Board shall record its final decision regarding the candidate's disability status with a speaking order, percentage of disability and eligibility under the PwBD category for NEET counselling. The decision of the Appellate Disability Assessment Board will stand final.

Step 6: Uploading and Communication of Decision

The final decision of the Appellate Board shall be communicated to Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) India, with a copy to **Dte.GHS**.

Step 7: Completion of Process

Upon communication of the decision, the appellate process shall be deemed complete, and the candidate shall proceed with the **NEET counselling process** in accordance with the final decision of the Appellate Disability Assessment Board.
